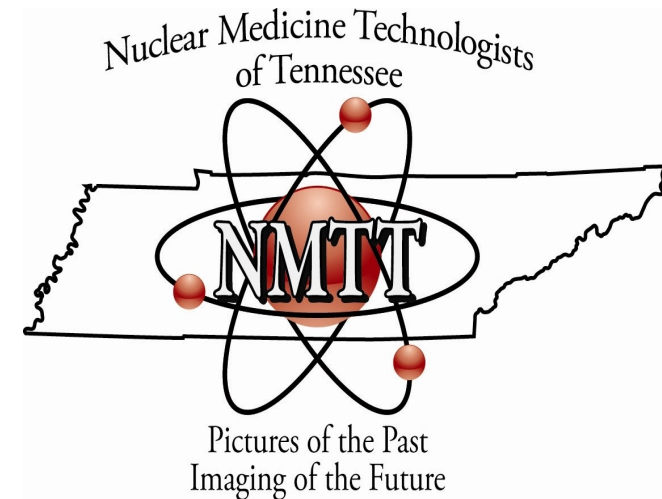
CONTINUING EDUCATION OVERVIEW
