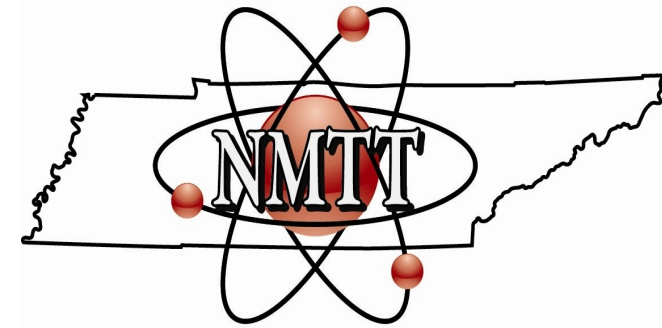
- CE credit will be awarded to those individuals who attend at least **80%** of each CE credit offered.
